

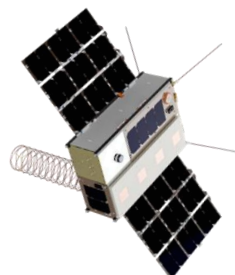

You will need to provide us with:

**your full name**

**the age category you are entering**

**your date of birth**

**your school or club name (if applicable)**

**email address** *(for under 16's this should be from a parent / guardian)*

**mobile phone number** *(for under 16's this should be from a parent / guardian)*

If you don't include all the correct information, your application may not be processed.

We accept individual applications or designs created by a group.

For group applications, all entrants must be in the same age category.

Please note that, unfortunately, we will not be able to return any posted entries to you.



### 3 WHAT NEXT?

---

Our judges will decide on a winner in each of the entry categories!

We will notify you by email and phone within one month of the competition closing date.

The overall winning design will be launched into Space on our Faraday-1 Satellite, where it will orbit the Earth at a speed of **7600 metres in ONE SECOND**, so it will travel **around the planet 15 times a day!** This is a rare opportunity!

### 4 YOUR PRIVACY

---

**It is important that you read this notice so that you are aware of how and why we are using your information.**

In accordance with data protection law, this privacy notice describes how we collect and use personal information about you, or the applicant who is under 16, during and after your connection with us.

#### **What will we collect and how will we use it?**

In-Space will collect and process the personal information that you have provided to us about yourself and / or your child by submitting your entry including your / your child's name, age, date of birth, email address and a contact telephone number. This is processed in the context of the competition and awarding process.

In-Space will retain your/ your child's personal information for 1 month after the competition closes.

#### **Sharing your information**

If you / your child wins one of the award categories, then your / your child's name might be disclosed to the public. The first name, age and their competition entry may appear in our office building or on our website.

We will share the personal data within our company and with the assigned judges solely for the purposes of the judging and contacting you. We will delete your personal data within one month of the competition closing.

We will anonymise the data and use it to generate statistics such as the number of entries and age groups. This will be for the purposes of improving our outreach and education activities. We will retain selected competition entries for promotional activities.
